

# BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING (ABSN)

For admission to Concordia's ABSN program, all candidates must meet BSN Admission requirements. All general education courses, with the exception of 6 credits of HUM and/or REL and all Nursing prerequisites must be completed prior to the start of the ABSN program. No more than 6 credits of nursing prerequisite coursework may be in progress at the time of application. Nursing prerequisite courses consist of BIO 211 General Biology 1: 4 Credits, BIO 284 Microbiology: 3 Credits, BIO 364 Human Anatomy & Physiology I: 4 Credits, BIO365 Human Anatomy & Physiology II: 4 Credits, CHM 101 Chemistry for Life: 3 Credits, CHM 102 Principles of Organic & BioChemistry: 3 Credits, PSY 321 Human Growth and Development: 3 Credits, MTH 123 College Algebra: 3 Credits, MTH 231 Research & Statistical Techniques: 3 Credits and ESS 462 Nutrition: 3 Credits.
